## Judicial Review Process Discontinued

**SAINT JOHN, NB:** On October 11, 2007 the Friends of Rockwood Park filed a Notice of Discontinuance with the Federal Court of Appeal in respect of the Judicial Review proceeding initiated in August.

This filing enables the construction of Brunswick Pipeline to commence in early November as planned, unencumbered by any outstanding appeal proceedings.

"FORP have played a valuable role to date in this community in raising awareness of the project and providing input on environmental mitigation" noted Robin McAdam, Brunswick Pipeline President. "We look forward to that input continuing."

The next steps for Brunswick Pipeline are to undertake various survey and clearing activities. Specific advisories on these activities will be issued in the near future.
