

## Geotechnical and Survey Work Coming Up

Brunswick Pipeline will begin three geotechnical and survey projects in the coming weeks as part of preparatory work required in advance of construction commencement in early November 2007.

Beginning October 18, 2007, rock sampling will be undertaken along much of the proposed pipeline route, including in Rockwood Park. A specially outfitted vehicle will travel the route, boring narrow core samples to a depth of 4 m. Typically, sampling is done every 25 m. No sampling is done within roadways, but rather is carried out on the shoulders of roads. The sampling results will be used by the construction team to plan blasting activity as well as to determine the sulphur content of the rock. The locations where environmental protection measures specific to acid rock handling are required will be identified.

Urban road crossing assessments will also begin shortly, and will be accomplished by drilling slim bore holes into the rock base of each road. Bore holes and core sampling will be taken from the shoulders of roadways rather than in the paved section. Samples will confirm the type, quantity and hardness of the bedrock at each location and facilitate road crossing planning. All road crossings are being planned in conjunction with the City of Saint John and New Brunswick Department of Transportation as appropriate.

Finally, in the next several weeks survey crews will begin flagging the limits of the 30 metre right of way (RoW) where easement options have been signed. Survey crews or Brunswick Pipeline staff will advise landowners when they are entering private property, so as not to cause undue surprise or concern.
