

Brunswick Pipeline project update

Pipe trains will continue to arrive in Saint John over the next month, with delivery expected to be completed by mid or late March. Approximately 20 km of pipe have been received to date. Deliveries of pipe joints to storage yards in west Saint John and along the rural area will be done during daylight hours. Arrangements have been made to ensure safe transportation.

Installation of the HDD casing at Spar Cove is complete and drilling of the pilot hole is expected to begin by Thursday, February 7, 2008. Preparation and set-up of the HD drill site in Milford is in progress, and drilling should begin by mid-February.

Rockwood Park construction is proceeding. Due to grading and blasting activities, some trails that cross the pipeline right-of-way (ROW) have been closed for public safety. Where possible, these trails will be kept open for Sunday walkers, but may have to remain closed for the safety of the public. Please check the notices posted at the Rockwood Park Interpretation Centre and trail entrances for up-to-date information. Security fences will be erected and moved as required. In addition to signage, trails will be manned when blasting is taking place to ensure public safety.

Finally, clearing of the ROW is under way between Forbes Drive and Spar Cove. Heavy equipment may be visible in places, and some movement of vehicles will be seen in the area.
