

## Project Update

Brunswick Pipeline has been in construction since November 2007. Since that time, a number of initiatives have been started. Noted below are those activities and their status. Brunswick Pipeline's target in-service date is November 2008.

Percentage of Detailed Route approved for construction by the NEB (based on a total of 30 km in the urban portion and 115 km in the rural portion)

- Urban: 20.8km/30.0km = 69%
- Rural: 100km/115km = 87%

### Clearing

- Urban: 17 % complete (remainder to be cleared or does not require clearing)
- Rural: 59 %

### Grading

- Urban: 9 %, currently grading in north Saint John between Forbes Drive and Spar Cove
- Rural grading will begin in May 2008

### Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD) of the St. John River

- Spar Cove side: 36 % of pilot hole completed
- Milford side: the noise mitigation tent has been erected and equipment is being installed; drilling to begin in early March
- the Spar Cove and Milford pilot hole drills should meet approximately mid-March
- meeting point will be below ground near the Milford shore

### Rockwood Park

- clearing and grading have been completed
- trenching: 90%
- have begun stringing pipe (laying pipe joints alongside the trench/RoW)

### Pipe delivery by train

- we have received approximately 44% of the pipe
- on target for the last delivery by approximately mid-March
