## BRUNSWICK PIPELINE'S PROPOSED DETAILED ROUTE

Brunswick Pipeline is seeking approval from the National Energy Board (NEB) for its 30 meter-wide easement within the approximately 100 meter-corridor approved by the NEB.

Representatives of Brunswick Pipeline will be on hand at each of the open houses to discuss the proposed detailed route with individual landowners, provide information about pre-construction planning and activities, and answer questions about the pipeline construction process.

The pipeline will extend through southwest New Brunswick to an interconnection with the Maritimes and Northeast Pipeline at the Canada/US border near St. Stephen, NB.
